4. All members are required to complete the application form fully. Receipts are only issued on request.
 5. A welcome pack will be emailed to new members upon joining, containing a copy of the DTC Constitution, Members' Handbook, Child Protection Policy and Code of Conduct. If you would like a hard copy of these documents Please make a stamped, addressed envelope to the value of €1.05 available to the Membership Secretary.
 6. Pavilion Membership allows access to all club facilities except the tennis courts.
 7. Full membership entitles the member to the use tennis courts as well as the clubhouse facilities.
 8. The tennis courts are for the use of Dunboyne Tennis Club members only. Guests are allowed on occasion but the rules in DTC's Members' Handbook concerning guests must be strictly adhered to.
 9. Key fobs will only be issued to fully-paid members who are over 18 years of age. If a fob is lost, a replacement fob will be issued on receipt of €5 to cover the purchase cost.
 10. Membership of Dunboyne Tennis club does not include coaching lessons unless otherwise stated. If you require either individual or group coaching, please contact a committee member.
 11. For reasons of health and safety, members must adhere strictly to the following:
 - Always warm up before the start of play.
 - Cups and mugs are not allowed on the tennis courts. Water may be kept in a plastic bottle.
 - Tracksuits or shorts/skirts and t-shirts must be worn at all times. Only suitable tennis attire is accepted at DTC.
 - Suitable footwear should be worn at all times: this means non-marking soles **ONLY!**
 - Members not taking part in a match are not allowed on the courts unless requested by a Junior Supervisor/Committee member.
 - Excessive or continuous noise-making/grunting is not acceptable. Mistreatment of equipment will also not be tolerated. Offensive language or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated.
 - Chewing gum, smoking and mobile phones are not permitted on the tennis courts.
 - Juniors cannot be left at the club before a coach/supervisor has arrived to supervise a junior session and the club will take no responsibility for juniors if they are left unsupervised.
 - Parents must check their child in with the supervisor before leaving the grounds of the club.

Should a member wish to terminate their contract before the end of the 'membership year', he/she will still be liable for any unpaid fees of the full year. Dunboyne Tennis Club Executive Committee reserves the right to exclude any member they deem not to be adhering to any of the above, or who, by their actions, poses a health and safety risk to others.
